Trends that hinder universal fraternity – Lacking a Plan for Everyone. Conflict & fear. “War, terrorist attacks, racial or religious persecution, and many other affronts to human dignity are judged differently, depending on how convenient it proves for certain, primary economic, interests. ... the first victim of every war is ‘the human family’s innate vocation to brotherhood’” ... new walls are erected for self-preservation, ... and leaves only ‘my world’, to the point that others ... become only ‘them’ ... [Section 25-28.]
