It is now necessary that we reflect together as a diocese on our varying experiences, positive and negative, of the living out our faith during this period. This will enable us to explore what can be learned for the immediate future. Your responses will help us to get a more informed overview of the strengths, lessons learnt, and weaknesses of our current situation as a diocese.

Quote from Pope Francis's Letter Fratelli Tutti

On fraternity and social friendship.

A better kind of Politics

[Section 154-197.] Here Pope Francis, in arguing for a better kind of politics that is "truly at the service of the common good", he looks at forms of politics "that hinder growth towards a different world," and at various self-serving attitudes ["concupiscence"] towards politics and leadership, and says: "Everything depends on our ability to see the need for a change of heart, attitudes and lifestyles", and thinks of the "long-term common good". He argues for "some form of world authority" that will "promote more effective world organisations" but also on a local level he writes of a "political love" and a "social love", which includes people from "every level of social life", including the marginalised, and where the politician says "if only I can help at least one person to have better life." He concludes with seven "real and potentially painful questions" for those in politics to ask themselves.
