The future of our parish

This weekend, we will hear a presentation at all Masses from a member of the Pastoral Team. All three of our Parish Pastoral Councils and the Pastoral Team have been discussing the future direction of our cluster for the past few months. We have had a year together in the cluster and there are lots of things we do together. At the moment, we are three separate parishes, which leads to a duplication of finance and admin systems, three sets of Parish Council and Finance Committee meetings and a sense of working together more challenging than it needs to be. The proposal now before all three parishes is that we formally merge to become one parish with three worshipping communities meeting in four churches. This is the direction of travel across the diocese as parishes come together in a cluster, then move towards a more formal joining together.

Please listen to the talk, take away the consultation leaflet, ask questions of any member of the Pastoral Team or Parish Council - - - and take the opportunity to respond either by filling in the leaflet or online.

There will be four opportunities to attend an open meeting to ask questions and give your views;

- Thursday 29th July, after the 10am Mass at St Augustine's.
- Friday 30th July after the 9am Mass at Sacred Heart,
- Monday 2nd August after the 9am Mass at Our Lady & St Edward's.
- There will also be an online meeting (by Zoom) on Monday 2nd August, 7 – 8 pm

Parish Celebration: On Sunday 29th August at 12.30 we will celebrate Mass on the grass at Our Lady & St Edward's Church, attended by Fathers Jonathan and Paul, to celebrate the years of ministry they have given to our parishes. Father Joe will be the main celebrant at the Mass. We hope you'll be able to join us for this special occasion. We'll have Mass followed by a relaxed opportunity to socialise, sharing food and friendship together. Mass Intentions: we have now caught up on our Mass intentions to be said, so thank you for your patience during this time. It is a lovely gift for someone to have a Mass said for the repose of the soul of a loved one, or for a particular intention. The Masses waiting to be said are all for specific dates and times sometimes we are not able to allocate them to the exact date or time requested. It helps a lot if Masses can be requested but no particular date required but we also realise that you would like all your family to be at an Anniversary Mass. Mass intention envelopes are available from the back of church and if you have requested a date don't forget to put your phone number or email address on the envelope.

Church Coronavirus Restrictions: although the Government has proposed to end all restrictions on 19th July, we need to wait until full guidance has been issued by the Government before taking any action. The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales will review this and then send out information and guidance to all Diocese. We then receive confirmation from the Health & Safety Department from the Nottingham Diocese what we can/cannot do. Let's continue to stay safe and be aware of our own personal safety, and that of others.
