This Sunday is designated as Safeguarding Sunday; it is a day of prayer for those affected by abuse, particularly at the hands of the church, and for all those who work to make our church communities safe places to be. Safeguarding of children and adults at risk is the duty of everyone – if we see or hear of something that worries us, we should always speak to someone about it; our parish safeguarding reps, one of the Pastoral Team or directly to the diocesan safeguarding department. All contact details are published each week in the parish bulletin. There is a letter from Bishop Patrick this weekend about safeguarding in our diocese; there are some copies at the back of church and a copy is displayed on the noticeboards. **Thank you to** Shelia, Anna and Julie, our parish Safeguarding Representatives. They manage the DBS checking process for volunteers and ensure that we follow all procedures and safe practices to keep children and adults at risk safe. This is a huge task and it is all done voluntarily so if they ask you to complete some paperwork, please do so promptly.

CAFOD APPEAL – URGENT SECOND COLLECTION TODAY FOR SUDAN or **donate on-line at cafod.org.uk:** Millions of families who have been forced to flee their homes due to conflict and are now facing yet another urgent crisis – hunger. Donations now will help provide emergency food packages, as well as other essentials like medicine. Water pipelines have been damaged, meaning that families are having to fetch water from unsafe locations. With your support, we can work to repair damage to pipelines and build new ones so that clean water can reach the communities who need it. We are providing emergency sanitation in several of Sudan’s largest refugee camps. This is a desperate need especially for the sick, the elderly, those with young children.

Live Simply: As well as supporting CAFOD’s emergency appeal for Sudan this week, we can support their longer term work in reducing hunger. 2024 marks the 80th birthday of the World Bank, a publicly-funded bank created to eradicate poverty. But with 2.4 billion people having no regular access to food, CAFOD says the World Bank is not doing its job. Small farmers are calling on the World Bank to protect their rights to freely access their own seeds. The World Bank has been pushing for laws that benefit big business selling commercial seeds, reducing or even criminalising small farmers’ rights to freely access them.
